

Auswanderung Sandmann 1889

Im Jahre 1888/1889 ist ein Anton Sandmann aus Kroge und seine spätere Frau Agnes Borgerding aus Bergfeine gemäß Volkszählung 1900, ausgewandert. Eine Passagierliste konnte nicht gefunden werden.

Mrs. A. Sandmann Is Buried In St. Gregory's Cemetery

Funeral rites for Mrs. Agnes Sandman, 80, who died February 20, 1952, at Frank Sandmann's residence, Marysville, were held Monday at St. Gregory's Catholic church. Burial was in the church cemetery.

Rosary was recited Saturday and Sunday evenings at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Frank Ruhkamp.

Mrs. Sandmann was born April 27, 1871 in Bergfeine, Germany. After emigrating to this country she was married November 25, 1885 to Antone Sandmann in St. Gregory's Catholic church.

With the exception of 10 years when she resided in Seneca, all the remainder of her life was spent in the Marysville community.

She was a member of St. Gregory's Catholic church.
